This is a unique opportunity to see the working of Free Legal Aid System and different stakeholders with each other to ensure that the awareness of various welfare scheme of Government as well as that of functioning of DSLSA/NALSA reach to the marginalized sections of the society.

We invite motivated law students who take initiative and have zeal to work for the marginalized sections of the society to join hands with us. We welcome students who are socially active, have a positive attitude and empathy to work for different sections of the society.

Who can apply:

Law students either of Five years or Three years degree course are eligible to apply for this program. Preference would be given to students of second year and above.

Skills required:

Efficiency in written Communication (English & Hindi both), Legal writing, Basic legal knowledge, Computer Operation in Word/Excel/PPT.

Timeline:

- **1st May, 2023 (From 10:00 AM onwards)**

Students can apply online for Summer Internship Program -2023 through DSLSA's official website i.e. www.dslsa.org.

- **15th May, 2023 (Till 5:00 PM)**

Last date for submission of applications. Application should be submitted with scanned copy of Identity Card issued from College/University & passport size photograph of the applicant & a Statement of Purpose for doing Internship written by the Student/Applicant himself/herself in max. 100 words.

- **27th May, 2023**

Students will be shortlisted and selected on the basis of their expression of interest through the Statement of Purpose submitted with the application and draw of lots, if more than required applications are received. The shortlisted students will be informed in due course.

- **1st June, 2023 (Last Date for Willingness)**

Students shall however send a confirmation e-mail @ legallitwing-dlsa@nic.in of their participation in Internship Program positively within 5 days of receipt of information of being shortlisted. Last date for confirming the participation shall be 1st June, 2023.
